I wish to express my concerns about the changes to Amateur Radio licensing.

I would like the present system of 'entry by examination' kept in place. Also, the database of licensed radio amateurs should be kept in place for reasons of accountability.

Perhaps the responsibility for these tasks could be passed onto the Radio Society of Great Britain (RSGB) with a condition that amateurs DO NOT have to be members of the RSGB in order to gain access to the amateur bands.
