

**Question 1: This executive summary sets out Ofcom's proposals for the release of the digital dividend. Do you agree with these proposals?..:**

No It is not a level playing field so market forces cannot be applied to PSB esp the BBC

**Question 2: Do you have any comments on our analysis of the essential constraints that will apply to the available UHF spectrum?..:**

A single Digital Network should be used, and there would be space for Freeview SD plus HD, and some UHF to be sold off. At the present situation no spectrum should be sold all must be allocated for HD DTT.
