

As I understand it this question revolves around whether my listening pleasure will be disrupted by someone else using an FM transmitter to listen to his iPod.

This seems to be very unlikely. Firstly the limited range of 8 metres means that I would need to be very close to even have a chance of detecting the transmitter. Secondly if they have chosen a waveband that is in use by a radio station, and in the unlikely event that it is the one that I am listening to, then they will receive interference with this radio station, and will change channel.
