

Comments on Ofcom's Proposal:

Inmarsat would like to thank Ofcom for giving us an opportunity to comment on its Notice of proposal to make (Ultra-Wideband Equipment) (Exemption) Regulations.

We generally support the text contained in Annex-5 of the consultation document.

In particular we support the limits given in Paragraph 4 (4) (a) at frequencies below and up to and including 1.6 GHz. These limits are necessary to ensure the compliance of UWB equipment in not causing any interference to GSO MES terminals operating in the frequency band 1525-1559 MHz

We also support the limits given in Paragraph 4 (5) (a) (i) at frequencies between 3.4 GHz and up to and including 3.8 GHz without any mitigation techniques and in Paragraph 4(5) (b) at frequencies between 3.4 GHz and up to and including 3.8 GHz with low duty cycle mitigation technique. These limits are necessary to ensure the compliance of UWB equipment in not causing any interference to GSO MSS feeder links operating in this part of the frequency band i.e., 3.550-3.700 GHz
