

Comments on Ofcom's Proposal:

We have two comments on the regulations, which we broadly support.

1. For regulatory certainty it would be clearer to include the 2010 'interim dates' in the regulations (relating to the 4.2-4.8GHz band.)
2. While we support the inclusion of the limits in the regulations, the limit level above 10.6GHz (clause 4.4.f) has no upper frequency limit. At very high frequencies, as the noise floor increases, it will be impossible to meet this requirement. We believe the limits above 10.6GHz (and below 1.6GHz) need not be included in national regulations. Compliance with RTTE Directive should suffice.
