

Solent regional independent local radio licence applications

Questions and responses: C106

These are the responses received from C106 to the non-confidential questions asked by Ofcom regarding their application for the Solent regional licence.

1. What is the radio station launched in Dublin by Atlantic referred to on page 10 of the application, and can you please provide further details of Atlantic's involvement in this station.

The Dublin station referred to on Page 10 of our application is Lite FM (now Q102) where I was a director of the company from its award in 1999 to 2002. I was actively involved with the management of the launch and operation of the station for over three years. This included research, operations, and financial management (yearly budgets and forecasts).

In addition, a number of the shareholders in Atlantic Radio Limited are also shareholders (circa 35%) in The Radio Development Company Limited (RDC) which was the shareholder which held the stake in Lite FM.
