

Application for 5 MHz Notice of Variation (NOV) to Full UK Amateur Licence

This application form is for the use of holders of the Full UK Amateur Radio Licence, who wish to request a Notice of Variation which will permit them to operate on certain 'spot' frequencies in the 5 MHz HF range for a limited period. The Notice of Variation cannot be issued to a licence held on behalf of a Club. The NOV shall only vary an applicant's licence for a temporary period and use of the 'spot' frequencies will not be permitted under CEPT Recommendation TR 61-01 outside the UK or its territorial waters. The applicant must also understand that by completing and submitting this application, he/she will be required to operate totally within the 3 kHz bandwidth channels specified in the Notice of Variation. The applicant will also be invited to operate the station in accordance with the 'Operating Procedures' (5 MHz doc.02 – or subsequent issues) supplied with this application form (or available at http://www.rsgb-spectrumforum.org.uk/Papers/HF/Operating%20Procedures%20v3_3.pdf on a voluntary basis.

Please complete all fields clearly in black pen and using block capitals. If you do not have a mobile telephone number write 'NONE'. It is a condition of issuing the NOV that the licensee must be contactable via a telephone located at or close to the station. This is to facilitate the issue of instant closedown instructions by a person authorised under authority of The Secretary of State or any government or military official. It will assist the process of vetting your application if you attach a photocopy of your **current Amateur Radio Validation Document or Licence**.

Data Protection Act: The information you provide in this application and any information submitted will be released by Ofcom for the purpose of issuing an NOV to a Full UK Amateur licence for operation in the 5 MHz Experimental Bands. The information may be provided by Ofcom to the Radio Society of Great Britain and the Ministry of Defence. See Ofcom's website www.ofcom.org.uk for our data protection statement.
