**NOTICE OF PROPOSED LICENCE VARIATION**  
**SECTION 10 and Schedule 1 (7) OF THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT**  
**2006**  
**LICENCE NUMBER [NUMBER] FOR FIXED LINKS LICENCE CLASS.**

**Introduction**

Ofcom proposes to update and vary your licence later this year. This is being done for a number of reasons

- To ensure your conditions reflect the changes in the Wireless Telegraphy Act 2006 and previous changes in the Communications Act 2003
- To provide greater certainty about the circumstances under which Ofcom may revoke licences
- To have licences all on the same terms wherever possible
- These changes should also bring more certainty to the rights in licences which became tradable at the end of 2004, and we are targeting classes where this will apply.

**Proposed Licence Changes**

Ofcom proposes to vary your existing licence by issuing you with a set of general licensing conditions for your licence class which make a number of changes to your licence. The key changes concern the circumstances of licence revocation and licence term. These changes follow the proposals set out in the statement published on Ofcom's website on 6 August 2004 entitled "A Statement on Spectrum Trading". Ofcom also proposes to revoke licences in the 1452 MHz to 1492 MHz band on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2007, following the notice letter sent to all affected licensees in September 2006.

In accordance with Schedule 1(7) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 2006, you have the statutory right to make representations to Ofcom if these changes are of concern to you, and Ofcom must consider your comments before taking a final decision on whether to make these changes. Such representations must be made by 18<sup>th</sup> May 2007 if they are to be taken into account by Ofcom.

However Ofcom would like to emphasise that these changes do not take away any of your existing rights: rather they give you much more certainty about the continuation of the licence, provided you adhere to the conditions.
