

Discontinuing licence conditions

A Statement by the Director General of
Telecommunications

November 2003

Introduction

1. On 23rd July 2003 the Director General of Telecommunications (the Director) continued a number of licence conditions. The licences to which those conditions were attached were revoked on 25th July 2003 under powers granted to the Director by the Communications Act 2003 (the Act). On 10 Sept 2003 the Director set out in a Statement the reasons for the continuation of these conditions. On 2nd October 2003 the Director issued a consultation document on the process and the methodology which was to be employed in discontinuing those continued provisions.
2. The purpose of this Statement is to respond to the comments made on the proposals set out in the consultation document of 2nd October.

The responses to the consultation

3. Only three responses were received, from Orange, T-Mobile and BT. A summary of the responses and the Director's comment upon them are set out below.

Orange

4. Orange made the point, in relation to Interconnection Directions, that Direction No. 43 had been mismatched. Orange says that the direction relates to the sharing of costs for customer sited interconnect which is the subject of an active dispute between Orange and BT, being considered currently by the Director.
5. Orange argues that while this dispute is active, the fact that it has been examined in relation to the fixed narrowband, wholesale access call origination, conveyance and transit markets review means that it must be discontinued and if necessary replaced with regulation under the new regime. Orange appears to be concerned that the Director's ability to make an award may be inhibited if the direction were discontinued.

The Director's response

6. Customer sited interconnect along with other interconnection circuits has been defined as a technical area in the identified market review. The transitional provisions of Schedule 18 of the Act permit such an award to be made under the new regulatory regime and as such the progression of the dispute will not be effected by the discontinuation of the direction. In addition, the Director is required under the provisions of Schedule 18 to discontinue the direction as soon as a decision has been taken about whether to replace the direction with a condition under the new regime.

T-Mobile

7. T-Mobile commented that the continuation notice which applied to it could be construed as continuing all of the provisions of its licence, in addition to those set out specifically. It sets out the following text from the continuation notice.

'The conditions set out in the licence granted by the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry on 9 May 1995 to the Licensee under section 7 of the Telecommunications Act ("the Original Licence") and set out in Schedule 1 to this notice, will continue to have effect from 25th July as modified and to the extent set out in Schedule 1 ("the Continued Provisions")'

8. T-Mobile stated that arguably the wording has had the effect of continuing both the existing licence conditions and the licence conditions modified by Schedule 1.
9. While T-Mobile accepts that this argument is incorrect, it says that a considerable amount of time had to be devoted to dealing with the issue which could have been avoided by more precise drafting. It requests that the discontinuation notice is amended to remove this uncertainty.

The Director's response

10. Draft notices were made available to the former licensed operators for comment and no such interpretation was placed on this type of drafting by anyone. It should be borne in mind also that the process of discontinuation of continued provisions should follow the original continuation process.
11. The Director confirms that the phrasing in the continuation notices given on 23rd July 2003 was not intended to continue all of the licence conditions which were in place prior to 25th July 2003. Had the Director intended to continue all of the conditions, rather than just the conditions set out in Schedule 1 of the notice, he would have expressed this along the lines of continuing the conditions set out in the licence **and** those set out in Schedule 1 to this notice.
12. It is not considered appropriate therefore to produce additional drafting which might not necessarily add to clarity and indeed could create additional problems.

BT

13. BT made a number of comments in response to the consultation and for convenience these are set out individually followed by the Director's response in each case. In addition BT has made some technical drafting suggestions relating to the form of the discontinuation notice which the Director has noted. These will be considered in the context of the final versions of the BT notice and it is not intended to refer to them in this Statement.
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14. BT states that its principal matter of concern relates to timescales for the discontinuation process. It contends that the consultation document restates the Director's intention to conduct a short 14-day consultation on discontinuation following the completion of each market review. BT urges the Director to include in a statement following this consultation, a comprehensive template timetable for the discontinuation process from the completion of a market review to the implementation of the new framework.

The Director's response

15. BT stated that the consultation document restated the Director's intention to conduct a short 14-day consultation following the completion of each market review. The Director wishes to clarify that the 2nd October 2003 consultation set out his intentions in relation to discontinuing relevant conditions and interconnection directions as the forthcoming market reviews complete. At Annex A of this statement the Director has set out, for ease of reference, a list of the conditions and interconnection directions which will be discontinued as each market review completes, taking into consideration comments received during consultation. Therefore, there will be no further consultation on discontinuation in relation to those reviews referred to in Annex A. Discontinuation notices for those reviews will be given (in their final form) at the same time as publication of the final market review statements.

16. Oftel is progressing with the completion of the market reviews as quickly as it can and a considerable number of the statements relating to these reviews will be published shortly. The Director is anxious to complete these but is not entirely in control of the timetable. It would not be practicable to produce a comprehensive and definitive timetable now.

Condition 67 of the CNS Licence

17. BT says that it understood from Oftel that CNS C67 – Separate Accounts – would be maintained in force for the remainder of the financial year 2003/04. This is the position, since the accounts will be required to show compliance for the period prior to the ending of the licensing regime. Therefore reference to this condition has been removed from the table set out at Annex A.

Condition 69 of the BT Licence

18. BT in its response sought clarification on which provisions of Condition 69 will be retained until the completion of the Product management, policy and planning (PPP) review. The provisions of C 69.5-69.21 in so far as they relate to PPP, interconnection circuits and other products in the same charge control basket will be retained until this review is complete.

Condition 69A of the BT licence

19. BT states that clarification is needed on the position in relation to BT condition 69A “Charge Control for Portability Standard Services” It has been continued but is not mentioned in the first table. Oftel is considering the future control of BT’s charges for number portability and the market(s) in which such services fall. The Director considers it appropriate to maintain this continued provision in force pending completion of that analysis.

Condition 83. Local loop unbundling

20. BT inquires as to why the market review of Unbundled Local Loops which it understands OFCOM will be conducting during 2004, is not mentioned. It states that BT Condition 83 should be discontinued following the completion of this review.

The Director’s response

21. Condition 83 will be discontinued once the Local Loop Unbundling (LLU) review is undertaken and completed. The discontinuation of the Condition must happen irrespective of the outcome and irrespective of whether or not a new condition under the Act is imposed. The reason this market was not contained in Annex 3 of the Consultation on discontinuation was due to the fact that the LLU review is not currently underway and so it was not appropriate to consult on it at this stage.

Interconnection Direction 31

22. BT states that this Interconnection Direction is mismatched. While there may be a presentational error in the published table, the continuation of this Direction relates to the call origination market. The Director confirms that the reference to the NTS retail uplift was only included for clarity.

NTS voice termination market

23. BT asks for clarification as to the “NTS Voice Termination” market mentioned in table 2 in relation to Interconnection Direction 18 – specifically which market review it relates to. The reference to this market was erroneous and the Director confirms that this Direction will be discontinued following completion of the fixed narrowband wholesale access, call origination, conveyance and transit market review. As a result, reference to this market has been deleted from the table at Annex 1.

Interconnection Direction 25

24. BT states that this Interconnection Direction, which applies generally to interconnection and will be disapplied in toto at the end of the market review process, constitutes a breach of para 22(10) of Schedule 18 (to revoke a continued direction as soon as possible).

25. In the light of BT's response and having considered the position further, the Director accepts that the direction only effects the markets in the fixed narrowband wholesale access, call origination, conveyance and transit review and the fixed geographic call termination review for which statements are to be published shortly. He has, therefore, decided that it would be appropriate to discontinue this Direction following the completion of these reviews.
