

Dear Hazel and MSC members

The Wireless Advisory Group has produced a number of reports and recommendations relating to the 5GHz Band C spectrum;

- Authorisation considerations
- Interface Requirement
- Sharing studies of FWA with other services

These reports are now approved by WAG and we ask that these are considered in the MSC as part of the ongoing consultation process of making the 5GHz Band C spectrum available by the Summer this year.

Due to the tight timescales some aspects of the reports and the issues highlighted may need further work and represent 'work in progress' at this stage.

The final report that is being developed is the one on commercial considerations. This is almost complete but some editorial work is proposed by some members to 'tidy up' the document before formal completion.

The Radiocommunications Agency, and wider UK Government, is requested to read and consider these reports as part of the 5GHz Band C consultation process. WAG and its members request to be kept involved in the anticipated further developments.

We would also like to raise the issue of how Ofcom intends to consult with the FWA and WLAN industries in the future and would welcome your views on how this will be addressed.
