**Description of character of service**

Sunny Govan Radio is for the community of Govan. The station focuses on community needs, providing access to information, education and training, and enabling people to express opinions and discuss issues affecting them and their community.

The service broadcasts:

- Music. The main types of music broadcast over the course of each week are a range of music genres, including music from local musicians.
- Speech. The main types of speech output broadcast over the course of each week are: topics of local interest, features on arts and culture, community magazine programmes, local news and event information, information on health issues.
- The service provides original output<sup>1</sup> for a minimum of 12 hours per day.
- The service provides locally-produced output<sup>2</sup> for a minimum of 13 hours per day.

The studio is located within the licensed coverage area.

The service provides a range of community benefits (social gain objectives mandated by statute) for the target community, both on-air and off-air, and in doing so, achieves the following objectives:

- the facilitation of discussion and the expression of opinion,
- the provision (whether by means of programmes included in the service or otherwise) of education or training to individuals not employed by the person providing the service, and
- the better understanding of the particular community and the strengthening of links within it.

Members of the target community contribute to the operation and management of the service.

The service has mechanisms in place to ensure it is accountable to its target community.
