Description of character of service

Radio Warrington is for the whole community of Warrington regardless of age, faith, sexual orientation or ability. It provides a service which informs, includes and entertains. It encourages community involvement and carries out outside broadcasts from local events.

The service broadcasts:

- Music. The main types of music broadcast over the course of each week are: a range of styles and genres, including local music. Some specialist music is also featured.
- Speech: The main types of speech output broadcast over the course of each week are: local news and information, sports reports, interviews, discussions, advice.
- The service provides original output¹ for a minimum of 15 hours per day.
- The service provides locally-produced² output for a minimum of 13 hours per day.

The studio is located within the licensed coverage area.

The service provides a range of community benefits (social gain objectives mandated by statute) for the target community, both on-air and off-air, and in doing so, achieves the following objectives:

- the facilitation of discussion and the expression of opinion,
- the provision (whether by means of programmes included in the service or otherwise) of education or training to individuals not employed by the person providing the service, and
- the better understanding of the particular community and the strengthening of links within it.

Members of the target community contribute to the operation and management of the service.

The service has mechanisms in place to ensure it is accountable to its target community.

¹ Original output is output that is first produced for and transmitted by the service, and excludes output that was transmitted elsewhere before. Original output can be live or voice-tracked. Repeat broadcasts of original output do not count towards the minimum requirement.

² Locally-produced output is output made and broadcast from within the service's licensed coverage area.
