**Description of character of service**

1 Brighton FM is for the people of Brighton and Hove. It offers a friendly, inclusive and accessible radio station, broadcasting a varied selection of specialist music and talk programmes to reflect the diversity of the local community.

The service broadcasts:

- Music. The music broadcast over the course of each week is: varied genres of specialist music, including music from local and unsigned artists.
- Speech. The main types of speech output broadcast over the course of each week are: discussions, content produced by and about local community and charity groups, and events information.
- Programming is in English, with some programmes featuring Arabic content.
- The service provides original output<sup>1</sup> for a minimum of 15 hours per day.
- The service provides all locally-produced output<sup>2</sup>

The studio is located within the licensed coverage area.

The service provides a range of community benefits (social gain objectives mandated by statute) for the target community, both on-air and off-air, and in doing so, achieves the following objectives:

- the facilitation of discussion and the expression of opinion,
- the provision (whether by means of programmes included in the service or otherwise) of education or training to individuals not employed by the person providing the service, and
- the better understanding of the particular community and the strengthening of links within it.

Members of the target community contribute to the operation and management of the service.

The service has mechanisms in place to ensure it is accountable to its target community.

<sup>1</sup> Original output is output that is first produced for and transmitted by the service, and excludes output that was transmitted elsewhere before. Original output can be live or voice-tracked. Repeat broadcasts of original output do not count towards the minimum requirement.

<sup>2</sup> Locally-produced output is any output made and broadcast from within the service's licensed coverage area. It may include all types of local production.
