Statutory Notification: modification of designated USP condition 1

NOTIFICATION OF MODIFICATION OF REGULATORY CONDITIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 36, 37 AND 53 OF, AND PARAGRAPH 3 OF SCHEDULE 6 TO, THE POSTAL SERVICES ACT 2011

BACKGROUND

- A. On 5 September 2013, at Annex 8 to the consultation document entitled *Technical and minor amendments in postal regulation Notifications of proposed technical and other minor amendments to the Universal Postal Service Order and related conditions*, OFCOM published a notification in accordance with section 53 of, and paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 6 to, the Postal Services Act 2011 (the “**Act**”) setting out their proposals to modify Designated USP condition 1 (“**DUSP 1**”) pursuant to their powers in section 36 of the Act (the “**First Notification**”).
- B. In the same document, having carried out a review of users’ needs, OFCOM gave notice of their proposals to modify SI 2012/936, the Postal Services (Universal Postal Service) Order 2012.
- C. A copy of the First Notification was sent to the Secretary of State in accordance with Schedule 6 paragraph 5(1)(a) of the Act.
- D. In the First Notification (and the accompanying consultation document), OFCOM invited representations about any of the proposals set out therein by 7 October 2013.
- E. By virtue of section 53 of, and paragraph 3(5) of Schedule 6 to, the Act OFCOM may give effect, with or without modifications, to a proposal with respect to which they have published a notification only if they—
 - (i) have considered every representation about the proposal that is made to them within the period specified in the First Notification; and
 - (ii) have had regard to every international obligation of the United Kingdom (if any) which has been notified to them for this purpose by the Secretary of State.
- F. OFCOM received one response to the First Notification and has considered that representation made to them in respect of the proposals set out in the First Notification (and the accompanying consultation document).
- G. The Secretary of State has not notified OFCOM of any international obligation of the United Kingdom for this purpose.
- H. OFCOM is publishing modifications of the Postal Services (Universal Postal Service) Order 2012 with this notification.

DECISION

1. OFCOM hereby, in accordance with section 36 of, and paragraph 3 of Schedule 6 to, the Act and pursuant to powers and duties in section 36 and 37 of the Act, modifies DUSP 1 which was imposed on 1 April 2012, to make provision for matters set out in that section 36 and 37 with effect from 31 December 2013.
2. The modification to DUSP 1 is specified in the Schedule hereto.
3. The effect of, and OFCOM's reasons for making, this decision are set out in the accompanying explanatory statement.

OFCOM'S DUTIES AND LEGAL TESTS

4. OFCOM are satisfied that this decision satisfies the general test in paragraph 1 of Schedule 6 to the Act.
5. In making this decision OFCOM have considered and acted in accordance with their principal duty in section 29 of the Act and their general duties in section 3 of the Communications Act 2003.
6. Copies of this Notification and the accompanying explanatory statement have been sent to the Secretary of State in accordance with paragraph 5(1)(a) of Schedule 6 to the Act and to the European Commission in accordance with paragraph 5(2) of Schedule 6 to the Act.
7. The Schedule to this Notification shall form part of this Notification.
