



Children's opinion of the internet by age



- •Twice as many 12-15s as 8-11s say they forget about the safety rules when online
- •A third of 12-15s find it easier to talk about personal things on the internet and almost a quarter feel more confident on the internet than in real life.



NQC15 – Here are some things that people have said about the internet. As you read each one could you please give me a Yes or No for each one depending on whether you agree? (prompted responses, single coded)
