

Freedom of Information: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information dated 29 March about the NGR references for where transmitters were located for various radio stations. We have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

You asked:

Please could you supply me with the NGR references for where the transmitters were located for Buzz FM (102.4), Radio Harmony (102.6), Wear FM (103.4), Channel Travel Radio (107.6), River FM (103.4 & 107.7), KCBC (1584kHz) and Isle of Wight Radio (1242kHz).

We are unable to disclose the information you requested as this is exempt from disclosure under Section 44 of the Act. This part of the Act exempts information from disclosure if another enactment has said that it shouldn't - in this case s393 of The Communications Act 2003 - unless we have the consent of the business or it furthers Ofcom's duties, neither of which apply here.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for undertaking internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review.
