



BROADCASTING ACT 1996 (AS AMENDED BY THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT 2003)

NOTICE OF RENEWAL DATED 3 JUNE 2009

IN RESPECT OF LICENCE GRANTED TO DIGITAL 3 AND 4 LIMITED TO PROVIDE A MULTIPLEX SERVICE UNDER PART I OF THE BROADCASTING ACT 1996 AND DATED 19 DECEMBER 1997, AS VARIATIONS NUMBER 1 AND 2 DATED 13 NOVEMBER 1998, VARIATION NUMBER 3 DATED 4 DECEMBER 1998, VARIATION NUMBER 4 DATED 3 FEBRUARY 2003, VARIATION NUMBER 5 DATED 8 MAY 2003, VARIATION NUMBER 6 DATED 17 DECEMBER 2003, VARIATION 7 DATED 9 NOVEMBER 2004, VARIATION NUMBER 8 DATED 2 JUNE 2006, VARIATION NUMBER 9 DATED 19 FEBRUARY 2007, VARIATION NUMBER 10 DATED 6 JULY 2008, VARIATION NUMBER 11 DATED 10 OCTOBER 2006, VARIATION NUMBER 12 DATED 20 MARCH 2009 AND VARIATION NUMBER 13 DATED 2 JUNE 2009 (“THE LICENCE”).

WHEREAS:

- A The Licensee has applied by letter to the Office of Communication ('Ofcom') dated 5 August 2008 for the renewal of the Licence from 20 December 2010 (the Renewal Date) under section 16 of the Broadcasting Act 1996 (as amended) ('the 1996 Act'), such renewal to be on the same terms as those contained in the Licence immediately before the Renewal Date;
- B Ofcom has decided to grant such application for renewal and has determined the amount of the Renewal Payment and specified the percentage of Multiplex Revenue for each accounting period of the Licensee that will be payable by him in place of the payments required to be made pursuant to Condition 4(2) to (4) inclusive of the Licence during the period for which the Licence is to be renewed;
- C Ofcom has notified the Licensee of its determination of the amount of the Renewal Payment and the percentage of the Multiplex Revenue specified under Condition 4(2) to (4) of the Licence;
- D The Licensee has notified Ofcom in writing that it consents to the Licence being renewed on these terms;

Ofcom hereby gives the Licensee notice that the Licence shall be renewed with effect from 20 December 2010 and, subject to the Conditions set out in the Schedule and the Annex to the Licence, the Licence so renewed shall continue for a term of twelve years from 20 December 2010.

This Notice of Renewal shall be construed as if it formed part of the Licence and shall be governed by English law.
