Question 1: Do you agree with our analysis of consumer detriment on the 070 number range?:

Pricing is currently confusing & in many cases too high. Any scams should be stamped on with increased monitoring. 070 tariffs should be capped at a lower level but high enough to cover termination rates to mobile numbers & many international destinations.

Question 2: Do you agree that the costs outweigh the benefits in relation to closing the 070 number range and migrating users to an alternative range?:

Yes - there should be no migration to an alternative range.

Question 3: Do you agree that Ofcom should keep the 070 range open and monitor the market in light of enforcement action by PhonepayPlus?:

Yes - keep 070 open & monitor for abuse, although the scope for abuse would be reduced if tariffs were capped.

Ideally these services would be provided using 08 numbers to reduce the cost to the caller, however if their business model is based on 07 tariffs then it may not be possible for them to operate with lower rates. Needs further investigation.

Question 8: Do you agree that Ofcom should withdraw formally the requirement for pre-call announcements on 070 Personal Numbers?:

Yes - pre-call announcements are a retrograde step & clearly interfere with other services. Again if 07 rates were lower this would be irrelevant.
