## Q1 Do you agree with Ofcom's view that the proposed non-emergency healthcare service represents a justified use of a three-digit number? Please give reasons for your views:

I think there does need to be an alternative three-digit number to deal with non-emergency calls. It gives more choice to the public and should reduce unnecessary use of 999.
