What are your comments on these proposals?:

OFCOM needs to do a lot more to protect local broadcasting in the UK and look after listeners more than big business. The Big radio groups seem intent on destroying local broadcasting. My local ILR station is not a local radio station at all. Sure it says it has to broadcast 13hours a day but it sounds identical to all the other 'One Network' stations (music in the same order, same presentation style, competitions). I want my radio to be local, relevant to my area and entertaining.

OFCOM needs to get tougher and insist that the licences are 'local' radio stations - in this age of 24 hour cities more local broadcasting not less is required.

Network programming in my view tends to be very low quality. There needs to be a total ban on premium rate quizzes on local radio.

FM can-not be touched until a new technology is firmly established in cars.
