Additional comments:

It is not clear if only letters or packets or parcels as well are included. If parcels, I think that Royal Mail should go back to the situation that obtained prior to the separation of Parcelforce - i.e. that parcels should go to local sorting offices first before being delivered to a neighbour.

Question 1:Do you agree that Ofcom should grant approval to Royal Mail for the Delivery to Neighbour service? If not please explain your answer.:

No. I think that all postal providers should have to deliver to the named customer.
