The Local TV Network requests that Ofcom review its Code on Scheduling of TV Advertising so as to exempt Local TV (L-DTPS licensees) from current regulations regarding scheduling of advertisements.

We believe that exemption from the scheduling rules is a natural corollary of the exemption (which we greatly welcome) from the advertising minutage restrictions. We note that Ofcom said in its statement on Licensing Local Television of May 2012 that it would be prepared to consider the issue further. Local TV is, of course, in many ways analogous to local radio, and it seems to us that the absence of scheduling restrictions on radio works well, without evidence known to us of consumer detriment. At the moment, the rules could be very restrictive in the Local TV context, even preventing the scheduling of breaks within key programming such as local news bulletins. And also a significant administrative burden, particularly for the smallest licensees.

We hope that Ofcom will include this in its plans, in the near future.
