It is very expensive to call home so i looked on the internet and found websites that offer cheap international calls. I have 1 orange 1 T.Mobile contract so i am paying a lot of money already. Over the years many times Orange have charged me suddenly without any notice for calling these access numbers. So when I found the 03 service I was happy as they cannot suddenly charge me without at least informing me. I was using the service until it was suspended due to Orange blocking the 03 number and I was no longer able to call. This is clearly not fair. I have already paid for a unlimited landline service and this should allow me to cal 01 02 and 03 numbers however Orange EE are so tight that they dont want anyone making cheaper calls and want to rip off customers by charging more that £1 a minute to call pakistan mobile, when i can it is using the 03 numbers at no extra cost.
