## **Additional comments:**

No, not as proposed currently. I do not object to other people having this facility if they wish, however for me it is unnecessary as I am happy for the postman to leave my items in the porch. I am concerned that if I opt out my items will be returned to the depot instead, but if I do not opt out I will then have to traipse over to my neighbour's... If this system is to be implemented it needs to be much more sophisticated... a sticker on a letter-box, and an opt-in, out choice is not good enough... I want to keep the status quo, and I do not want to have to display my choice to the world.... nor to rely on something as flimsy as a sticker... there is no way it will stick to my letter box in any case... Royal Mail should have to come up with something far better than this in order to make this change.
