Additional comments:

Tyco has a major interest in the manufacture, installation and ongoing monitoring of alarms. This covers their use in both intruder and fire protection applications. We manufacture our own systems but also install and use those made by others. A significant proportion of these are wireless, part wireless, or are wireless capable.

Tyco also has other interests in monitoring and telemetry over a short range (such as monitoring personal protective equipment) and we would support the inclusion of the higher reliability benefits across wider applications.
