## Question 1:Do you agree that Ofcom should grant approval to Royal Mail for the Delivery to Neighbour service? If not please explain your answer.:

I agree in principle but ONLY if all parties agree, i.e. both the recipient and his/her neighbours. Therefore this must be done on an opt-in basis.
