OFCOM – Children's Media Lives Year 6

Sample Specification and Screener

PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project is about understanding the ways in which children and young people use a range of media (going online, watching TV, gaming etc.) and how they use technology in the context of everyday life.

We are also interested in how children feel about the different risks associated with using the Internet and things that may concern them. We will be asking children broadly about what they like to watch, and do online, and asking them if they have ever felt uncomfortable or experienced negative instances.

These questions will be open and non-pressurising: we will not be having conversations about any concern that is not raised by the child themselves. We will not be showing them any inappropriate imagery.

We have been commissioned to carry out this work by Ofcom, the communications regulator, and we're speaking with children (and their parents) across the UK.

The Communications Act 2003 places a responsibility on Ofcom to promote, and to carry out research into, media literacy and this research contributes to Ofcom's work in this area.

METHODOLOGICAL DETAIL

Research to be conducted in-home.

Research participants must:

- Be happy to participate in the project (in-home depth interview)
- Be happy for the duration of the interview to be **filmed**
- Be given an information sheet about the project (RR to provide information sheet for recruitment partner to send to participant) we would like the recruitment partner to confirm in writing that these information sheets have been sent to each participant
- Be happy to participate in the research in the future, which runs every year

Core elements:

In-home depth interview

An approximately 2 hour in-home visit to better understand the respondent's media consumption and behaviours. The entirety of the interview will be **filmed**, but this will not be made public.

The researcher will also use this visit to capture visual data (photography and 360 shots). Incentive: £50
