Question 1:Do you agree that Ofcom should grant approval to Royal Mail for the Delivery to Neighbour service? If not please explain your answer. :

No. My main concern is the "opt-out" issue.

Why should I place a sticker anywhere on my property to indicate that I don't either want my mail leaving with a neighbour, or to have neighbours mail delivered to my house. I WILL not accept mail, nor do I want mail delivering elsewhere, I especially have no intention of placing a sticker in windows, doors etc. This should be arranged at the sorting office, not at people homes.

If this service should be anything it should be an "opt-in" service.

Lack of proof of delivery is my main concern
