

## **Freedom of Information: Right to know request**

*“What is the total revenue from all spectrum licenses sales that have accrued to the UK government?”*

*Can these be split out between the different portions of the spectrum and split between one off license costs (which are now perpetual) and the ongoing annual costs.*

*Please could you also provide the future income expectations from spectrum sales and charges in the future.”*

Licence income is published – from the [Annual Reports and Plans](#) page, you can find it by going to the link [Spectrum management costs & fees](#).

Fees raised from awards were published for each award and can be found through the [Awards archive](#) page.

With some small variances (new licences, surrenders of others etc.) the annual income is unlikely to change significantly; the fees are set in the fees order and there are no proposed overall changes. Regarding fees for awards (auctions), as the auctioneer, we are not in a position to speculate or predict those

### Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for undertaking internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review.
