

Request for Information

Thank you for your request for information dated 25 August for an up to date list of revoked Amateur Radio licences as the previous list was dated 2015. This has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

We do not hold such a list. In 2015, we published a list of Amateur Radio Licences that we were revoking, in accordance with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 2016 and as provided for in Clause 4(3) and 4(4) of the Amateur Radio Licence. The list therefore formed part of a formal statutory notice. As such, it simply describes something that we did in 2015 and there was never any intention to update it. It is not, therefore, a 'living' list of call signs for licences that are currently revoked.

We do not currently publish a separate list of call signs that are licensed. However, we do make information available for the purposes of publishing a call book. For example, in its Yearbook, the RSGB includes all call signs, with contact details for licensees who have consented to have that data disclosed. You may therefore wish to compare the call signs on the list of revoked licences against a call book, such as the RSGB Yearbook.

If you are unhappy with the response or level of service you have received in relation to your request from Ofcom, you may ask for an internal review. If you ask us for an internal review of our decision, it will be treated as a formal complaint and will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will acknowledge the complaint and inform you of the date by which you might expect to be told the outcome.

The following outcomes are possible:

- the original decision is upheld; or
- the original decision is reversed or modified.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for undertaking internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review.
