Question 1: Should Ofcom exercise its discretion to consent to the application to vary the Bradford small-scale multiplex licensed area, with regard to the statutory and policy considerations set out in this document?	NO We are participating in this consultation on behalf of all our entities which were the part of our application for this Small Scale Multiplex for Bradford. We are writing to express our serious concerns regarding the recent Cover- age reduction request from Bradford Dab. Our organiza- tion, representing several local radio entities, partici- pated in the application process with the understanding that the key requirements for the license, particularly lo- cal support and technical plans, would be diligently as- sessed and upheld by Ofcom. It has come to our attention that despite our strong local support, which included numerous operational radio sta- tions based in Bradford and its catchment areas, our ap- plication was overlooked in favor of another applicant, Bradford DAB. Upon further investigation, it has become clear that the awarded licensee has failed to uphold the commitments made during the application process. Firstly, despite claiming significant local support, the Bradford DAB platform does not include any of the main local community radio stations on its carriage platform. This raises serious concerns about the accuracy of the support figures provided to Ofcom and highlights the po- tential for misleading information to influence the deci- sion-making process. Secondly, there are alarming indications that the licen- see intends to backtrack on its technical plans by reduc- ing coverage area by almost 35%, contrary to the initial promises made to Ofcom. This reduction directly contra- dicts the preference point awarded based on coverage area, with our group proposing coverage slightly below 80% compared to the other group's plan exceeding 80%.
Question 2: With reference to our im- pact assessment, do you agree with our assessment of the potential im- pacts of approving this application?	NO We firmly believe that such breaches of key commit- ments warrant a review of the license conditions by Ofcom to ensure fairness and transparency in the licens- ing process. It is imperative that the interests of all com-

	munity members, including local radio operators and lis- teners, are safeguarded against tactics aimed at circum- venting regulatory requirements for personal gain.
	We respectfully request that Ofcom thoroughly investi- gate the concerns raised and take appropriate action to uphold the integrity of the licensing process. Rejecting the coverage reduction request based on the evidence provided would serve to protect the future of DAB and local community radio stations, preventing undue ad- vantage to a single commercial radio station at the ex- pense of others.
