

Hi - Please do not allow Royal Mail to implement a scheme that will permit items to be left at neighbouring properties or vice-versa, this would not only be a breach of their legal contract to deliver addressed items to my specific address only, it would also open up old wounds to neighbours that do not particularly get along with each other due to past disagreements.

Also privacy, and my security will be placed at a high risk, as items are regularly delivered to myself which having undergone the rough handling at the mercy of Royal Mail have been damaged, part opened or are not securely sealed, this would give my nosy neighbour the opportunity to peek inside packages which is a clear breach of my interests that are expected and indeed Royal Mail are under contract to protect.

I am seriously considering issuing legal proceedings against Royal Mail the very first time that any parcel or package that is addressed to me is left with a neighbour or the other way around. This is a clear infringement of our rights to expect parcels to be either delivered to the intended address or returned to the depot for collection by the absent party at a convenient time if delivery cannot be served on the labelled address of the consignment.

I will register online to opt out as suggested in the leaflet as my initial protest that I am absolutely against this absurd and ridiculous illegal idea, but I do not want to have to display a opt/out sticker on my door or window that will allow the indignity of it being on view to my neighbour.
