What are your comments on these proposals?

I think Ofcom should look at the fuding of community radio Station's, as from 2008 funding from the EU will be cut so there will be a smaller amount of funding money available.

All community radio station's are "not for profit" this will be in their consitution or articlas & memoradums this therefore is their main part of their critria & socal gain for a community radio licence. i think that the community radio ststion should if feels the need due to difficalty obtaining funds from other sources be aloud to fund 100% via on air advertising as they are locked in to not disributing any surplas monies to any of the people managing or directors but to reinvest in the station and its community. the lifting 0f the 50% celling would give stations a fighting chance to survie as some station will and in some cases have folded.

This relaxion of the 50% rule WOULD NOT in anyway change the sprit of community radio and woud not brake the community radio bill.
