I also am very vulnerable as I have one arm in a sling (permantly now) and use a crutch to walk, have M.S and Epilepsy, so have enough to cope with, I dont go out when the weather is bad, for fear of slipping, if people lived in wonderfully supportive neighbourhoods then this may work, but today, no, where I live its cutthroat, I have had parcels from couriers and flowers delivered and I have been told the address the goods have been signed for at(via the card pushed through my door whilst I was out,) when confronted my neighbours denied this, I later discovered my flowers and presents were sold for alcohol and drugs, by my very neighbours so I have very little trust. If people are paying for a delivery service and stipulating as I do "leave only at this address" then I cannot stand when this service is breached. I also like the way now that I can contol when a parcel can be redelivered by royal mail, I rely heavily on door delivery nowadays due to my ill heath please dont rob that from me and put me in fear of playing delivery russian roulette style with the frequency of neighbours that flit in and around the area.

obviously it will have a positive/negative impact on royal mail itself. Also I do not want anyone else looking at my mail but me or my husband, i.e, if delivered elsewhere things can be opened, lost, private and confidential info seen, hospital appointments of which I have plenty could get missed if mail is not delivered correctly.
