

We protest against the Ofcom consultation to implement manual configurable WSD in the UHF-TV range!

Reasons are:

1. The EN 301 598 clearly requires a database with automatic configuration for the operational parameters for the WSD. The Ofcom approach is contrary to this. So we ask ourselves why we invest heavily into participating to form standards that protect applications if these are not binding.
2. If it is really necessary to operate a so called WSD outside the accepted standard Ofcom can grant an individual site license. By this Ofcom is also responsible that other existing spectrum users are protected against interference.
3. The Ofcom policy shown here is contrary to those followed by Ofcom in the WiFi range: here Ofcom does its utmost to reduce manual configuration for the operation, but wants everything to be handled automatically.

Due to these facts we see no need in answering the public consultation.
