## What are your comments on these proposals?:

I have no objection to the switch off of analogue broadcasts in the AM band. However I would object in the strongest possible terms to the loss of BBC national radio 1,2 and 3 broadcasts (i.e. music based) in the FM band. Ofcom should consider the fact that a large amount of electronic equipment will be rendered waste material if there is an analogue radio broadcast switch off.
The loss of these broadcasts would render useless five of my radio receivers, two of which I have owned for over 20 years and which still give excellent service.
The provision of more local radio at the expense of the loss of high fidelity music broadcasts catering for a wide variety of tastes, is not something I would support. I believe that most of the "local content" delivered by local and community radio could be most appropriately delivered by internet and not by speech.
