"111" is a poor choice. It is likely to receive a lot of calls made accidentally.

Please remember that loop disconnect dialling is still recognised on most exchange lines.

It is easy to "dial" 111 by accidentally fumbling with a phone handset, bouncing it on and off hook - this has the same effect as loop disconnect dialling. I also have experience of intermittent equipment failure "autodialling" 111 by making and breaking the local loop.
