

Annex A: EE's response to the Consultation

EE's comments in relation to Ofcom's published draft Wireless Telegraphy (White Space Devices) (Exemption) Regulations 2015 (the "Draft Regulations"), as set out in Annex 5 of the Consultation, are provided for Ofcom's consideration in the table below.

Table 1 – EE's comments in relation to the Draft Regulations

Regulation	EE's comments
2	EE suggests re-drafting as follows [underlined]: "These regulations shall <u>apply in the United Kingdom and Isle of Man, and shall</u> not extend to the Channel Islands".
7(5)(b)	EE suggests referring specifically to regulation 7(6).
7(6)	EE suggests re-drafting as follows [underlined]: "master device must communicate with that designated database every update period, <u>as defined in regulation 7(7),</u> for confirmation..."
13(a)	EE notes that Ofcom's Statement concluded that no White Space Device (WSD) use of DTT channel 60 is permitted anywhere in the UK or Isle of Man ¹ . EE strongly suggests that this is specified explicitly in the regulations (with reference to the definition of DTT channel 60 in Schedule 2).
Schedule 2	EE suggests that Schedule 2 should specify that WSD use of DTT channel 60 is not permitted anywhere in the UK or Isle of Man.
