Q1 Do you agree with Ofcom's view that the proposed non-emergency healthcare service represents a justified use of a three-digit number? Please give reasons for your views. :

No. I believe the existing NHS Direct number is adequate. The money could be better spent promoting this number for non-emergency advice.

Q2 Do you agree with the DHs view that:

- A) a three-digit number is the best choice for the proposed service and
- B) of the three-digit numbers available, 111 is the best option?

Please give reasons for your views.:

No. The 111 number is only one digit different from the 112 number. The final digit is also immediately next to that of the alternate emergency number. I strongly believe that using 111 will result in a large number of misdialled calls to the emergency services.

Q3 What are your views on the tariff options selected by the DH?:

I believe the existing NHS Direct number should be preserved. But if possible, a free tariff would be preferable as the NHS guiding principle is that it should be free at the point of service.
