Additional comments:

I object on the grounds that households should have the opportunity to register to opt out of the proposals without having to display a notice to that effect on the premises.

Question 1:Do you agree that Ofcom should grant approval to Royal Mail for the Delivery to Neighbour service? If not please explain your answer.:

No. The proposal doesn't include the oportunity for individual properties to not be included in the proposals other than displaying this on the property.

Question 2:Are there other consequences following the roll out of the service across the UK that we have not included in our assessment? If so, please explain.:

Mail delivered to neighbours is often difficult to collect due to neighbours not being available at suitable times. We are frequently away from our home and if a neighbour doesn't collect their post proptly they may not be able to access it for several weeks. Conversly our neighbour may be away on holiday when we return home to collect post from them.
