Our response

Ofcom's regulatory work is funded by a avariety of stakeholders. As a Networks & Services stakeholder that meets specific criteria set out by Ofcom in its Statement of charging principals, Vodafone is liable for an administrative charge under Section 38 of the 2003 Communications Act.

Our Statement of Charging Principles provides further details on the applicable fee criteria in this sector.

Vodafone is also liable as a mobile and network operator for a wireless telegraphy act licence fee under The Wireless Telegraphy Act. These funds are transferred to the Department of Digital, Culture, Media and Sport. Please refer to our annual Section 400 Licence Fees and Penalties Accounts.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
