Ofcom's Wales office received your enquiry on 26 November 2024 and it was passed to the Information Requests team. We have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("the FOI Act").

Your request & our response

We do not hold a list of these services categorised by area or region.

However, we do publish a list of community radio stations on our website.

This specific page sets out the name of the service and the area they are licensed to broadcast to. If any licence doesn't have the location specified explicitly on the list, individuals can click the link and access either the coverage map and/or the Key Commitments which will signal the location. We also have a <u>look up page</u> more generally for all of our licensed products, which also includes digital Community Radio licences.

Request an internal review

If you are unhappy with the response you have received to your request for information, or think that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

If you would like to ask us to carry out an internal review, you should get in touch within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
