Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information about legal recruitment.

We received this request on 24 March 2025 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("the FOI Act").

Your request and our response

- During the financial year of 2023/2024 how many Lawyers worked at OFCOM as either LOCUM contractor or were introduced by an agency on a Fixed term Contract basis?

In the 2023/2024 financial year we had no contract Lawyers introduced by an agency. All were directly recruited via Recruitment Process Outsourcing (RPO)) with OMNI, through various sources (e.g. job boards, LinkedIn, referrals, etc).

- During the financial year 2023/2024 how many permanent Lawyers started in OFCOM and were introduced through an agency?

In the 2023/2024 financial year, we did not hire any permanent lawyers through an agency. All were directly recruited by OMNI as explained above.

But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
