Hi both,

Today we have issued a note to broadcasters outlining that we will not be reaching final decisions in any ongoing cases concerning rules 5.1 and 5.3 (cases involving politicians presenting news) for the time being. This is due to an upcoming hearing – due to take place in January 2025 - on GB News's challenge to two of our decisions concerning the scope and application of rules around politicians presenting news content. Therefore, Ofcom has decided, in these exceptional circumstances, not to reach a final decisions on any relevant cases before we have received the Court's judgment. All licensees subject to these investigations have already been informed.
