Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information concerning Juice Belfast. We note that this is in response to Ofcom's recent [breach decision](#).

We received this request on 14 October 2025 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the 'FOI Act').

Your request & our response

"Could I ask you to provide the following details as your ruling references them:

1 The address of the studios of Juice Belfast

Information for Juice Belfast is available on our [website](#), including the public contact details we hold for communications relating to the licence/licensee.

While we do hold information about other addresses associated with this licensee, we consider that disclosure of this information is exempt under the FOI Act as this information relates to a business that we regulate, and we requested the information to assess the complaint, not to provide to third party individuals. In particular, section 44(1)(a) of the FOI Act exempts disclosure of information if its disclosure is prohibited under another enactment. Ofcom is prohibited under section 393 of the Communications Act 2003 ("the Communications Act") from disclosing information about a business which we have obtained in the course of exercising a power conferred by the Communications Act among others, unless we have the consent of that business or one of the statutory gateways under section 393(2) of the Communications Act is met, neither of which applies here. Section 44 is an absolute exemption and therefore is not subject to a public interest test.

2 You reference a show called 'A Morning Dedicated to Matters' please state what time this is broadcast (as I listened in periodically today from 7am and did not find it)?

We do not hold information about the regular scheduling of this programme. As noted in the breach decision referred to by your request, we only have information about when this programme was broadcast during the week beginning 12 May 2025; this information is reflected at page 5 of the decision:

Having assessed the recordings and the information the Licensee provided for the week commencing 12 May 2025... The 'AMDMS' [A Morning Dedicated to Matters] show [was] broadcast at 05:00 to 06:00 on weekdays and 07:00 to 08:00 on Saturday and Sunday...

For accurate, current details as to the scheduling of this programme, we would advise contacting the licensee directly. The contact details for the licensee can be found in the link to our website provided in our response to question 1 above.

3 Is 'A Morning Dedicated to Matters' original content each day or a repeat of the same program across the week?"

We do not hold this information.
