I am writing to formally request the disclosure of full details of any licenses issued by Ofcom for the property located at or about the above address. Specifically, I am requesting the following information:

- 1. The name(s) of the license(s) holder or entity to whom the license(s) has been issued.*
- 2. The type of license(s) granted.*
- 3. The purpose or use case of the license(s).*
- 4. The frequency band(s) allocated to the license holder.*
- 5. The specific frequencies assigned to the license(s) holder.*
- 6. The geographic coverage area covered by the license(s).*
- 7. Details of the devices or equipment associated with the license including all sensors, transducers, transmitters, receivers, audio visual equipment and antennas.*
- 8. Technical specifications for the devices or equipment, such as transmit power, modulation types and any emission characteristics.*
- 9. Terms and conditions associated with the license, including any performance obligations, coverage requirements, or service provisions.*
- 10. Compliance with regulatory obligations, including any required reporting or performance standards.*

Request an internal review

If you are unhappy with the response you have received to your request for information, or think that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

If you would like to ask us to carry out an internal review, you should get in touch within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
