Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request concerning complaints about a Faith TV broadcast.

We received this request on 15 July 2026 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request & our response

I am writing to enquire whether Ofcom received, considered, or otherwise dealt with any complaints relating to a live Faith TV broadcast on or around 6 March 2023, during which Pastor Andre Roebert reportedly made remarks concerning Orania, a legally established Afrikaner cultural community in South Africa.

I would therefore be grateful if you could assist by clarifying the following:

- 1. Whether Ofcom received any complaint(s) relating to this broadcast.*
- 2. Whether the matter fell within Ofcom's jurisdiction.*
- 3. Whether the complaint(s), if any, were investigated, assessed, or otherwise considered.*
- 4. Whether any findings, determinations, correspondence, or regulatory decisions were issued.*
- 5. If no investigation proceeded, whether you are able to indicate the reason (for example, jurisdictional or procedural grounds).*
- 6. If any public records, case references, or published decisions exist in relation to this matter, I would be grateful if you could direct me to them.*

Ofcom has received no complaints regarding the matter you refer to above.

Request an internal review

If you are unhappy with the response you have received to your request for information or think that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

If you would like to ask us to carry out an internal review, you should get in touch within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
