Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information concerning Video Content Library Limited.

We received this request on 11 June 2026 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“the FOI Act”).

Your request

“I am seeking information regarding Video Content Library Limited, company number NI622105.

I have found a reference to Video Content Library Limited in an Ofcom on-demand programme services access services report. I would like to confirm whether Video Content Library Limited has ever been registered with, notified to, regulated by, or otherwise recorded by Ofcom as an on-demand programme service provider or related media service provider.

If any public register entry, historic service name, trading name, contact details, responsible person, or regulatory correspondence route exists, I would be grateful if you could direct me to it.”

Our response

We can confirm that Video Content Library Limited was registered with and regulated by Ofcom, however, it ceased to distribute services in 2018. There is a version of the list of notified On Demand services from 2017 on the [National Archive website](#) with confirmation of the notification and the following details:

If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
