Our response

We provide data on fixed broadband availability at postcode level as part of our [Connected Nations publications](#); the most recent data sets can be found [here](#). Availability figures for different speed brackets are provided as the percentage of premises with access to a maximum download speed in a particular speed bracket.

For developers we provide an Application Programming Interface (API) to the address-level fixed broadband data that feeds our coverage checker, subject to certain restrictions on the extent to which data can be accessed and the purpose(s) of use. Information about our broadband coverage checker and the API is available on [our website](#). Users will have to sign up on our API portal, or register with the API team (cnapisupport@ofcom.org.uk), to access the data, and accept the associated terms and conditions of use on application.

Request an internal review

If you are unhappy with the response you have received to your request for information, or think that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

If you would like to ask us to carry out an internal review, you should get in touch within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
