With G.fast coming soon and FTTP wanted by all then setting a minimum of 10 is too low.

I think it is more important to bring back 'fttp on demand', and now to implement a 'fttdp g.fast on demand'.

I know these cost a lot in places - but Ofcom and USO should come up with a workable cost formula to provide these services to all. If USO just states a minimum of 10 then that is something that the providers can use to NOT provide new technology service to a property, instead of making a service available to all.

I also want to see an end to 2 tier exchange prices. If someone sells a service in one exchange at £XX then that should be the same for the whole country - this would effectively subsidise the worst off (which is good).
